As one of the founding families of the greater Hamilton area, in 1773, the Christopher family purchased 50 acres in what is today Westfield. Indeed, many of our streets are named after the descendants of these founding Quaker settlers. Today, the Christopher Family Cemetery, located at the end of Royston Ave., is threatened by development. Lisa Kraus' presentation tells the Christopher Family's story as an integral part of Westfield's history.
